



5 STAR LEADER TRAINING – SEA (Skye)

What Paperwork Do I Need?

When you meet your trainers at **20.00**, they will need to see the following:

- Note: It is not essential to be a member of either canoe unions to undertake training. However, we recommend that all students join before attending. Tel BCU on 0845 370 9500; or Tel SCA on 0131 317 7314.
- BCU 4 Star Leader Sea Award or old style Level 3 Sea Award.

What We Cover

This three-day course will provide relevant training to allow paddlers to work towards sitting their BCU 5 Star Sea Leader Assessment. The Sea 5 Star Leader Award is a discipline specific award and you will receive training in sea in appropriate advanced sea conditions and environments.

The training course will include personal paddling, tidal planning equipment awareness, environmental awareness and supporting knowledge. In addition to this safety and rescue will be covered along with leadership of small groups of peer paddlers. Over the three days this will include the BCU Sea Kayak Open Water Navigation and Tidal Planning Course as well as the 5 Star Sea Leader Training. As part of the training course it is anticipated that

All of the above will be covered using the fantastic locations that are on offer in the North Skye area. Our accommodation also has classroom facilities.

As part of the training course it is anticipated that an overnight camp and a night paddling exercise will take place, please bring head-torches, light sticks and any personal camping equipment you have for this. Expedition food will be supplied by Glenmore Lodge, equipment can be supplied if required.

The course will finish by giving you a clear feedback and an action plan as to how to progress to a BCU 5 Star Sea Leader Assessment.

The Accommodation

This course will be based at the Whitewave outdoor Centre in the North of Skye, 4 miles north from Uig.

Set in a beautiful location within the small community of Linicro, Whitewave enjoys fabulous views across open countryside and on towards the sea.

All catering will be done by the centre so the evenings are available for relaxing and some theory sessions.

By Car:- From Armadale or Kyle of Lochalsh follow signs to Portree on the A850, from Portree follow signs to Uig along the A856. Drive through Uig, turning right to Kilmuir, not following the road to the Pier. The road is now the A855 and is single track (remember to use the passing places properly). There is a sharp hairpin bend, and at the top of the hill ignore the turn off to Staffin and the Quiriang and continue north for 3 miles. No.19 is a large house on the right. Look out for the wind turbine next to it!!

It is anticipated for the second night we will be out on expedition and using camp based accommodation. Please bring appropriate equipment for this, Glenmore Lodge can help with this if needed. Expedition food will be provided by Glenmore Lodge.

Arrival & Departure Information

The course will begin on the first evening with an opening brief at **20.00** (please try to make it on time with all your paperwork). **We will meet you on Skye** so please arrange your own travel arrangements. If you need assistance with this please get in contact with us and we will be happy to help. The course will finish by 17.00 on the last day.

B&B may be available on the final night at Glenmore Lodge, please book this in advance. Accommodation may also be available at Whitewaves on the final night, please contact them direct to arrange this.

What Will I Need?

If you need equipment please let us know in advance so we can bring it across for you a form is attached, please return this form to us even if no equipment is required. Please note that we are only able to supply you with a low spec plastic boat.

Glenmore Lodge has a large, and very comprehensive store of up to date clothing and equipment. You are welcome to use your own equipment and pick and choose odd items from the store. Your instructor will want to check that personal equipment is appropriate for the activity.

If you are thinking about buying equipment but are not too sure what to get we would advise you to come and try our equipment and then make your purchases after the course. We have a range of most equipment items you can try during the course and there is advice on hand from other students as well as the staff.

We have a range of some of the latest river kayaks from Pyranha and other top manufacturers. All our Sea kayaks are this years models from P&H and Valley. Our Open boats are all new from Mad River. The surf kayaks are also of up to date design.

Our paddling clothing is from Peak and we have a wide range tailored to your discipline.
