

BCU 5 Star Leader Training – Surf (Thurso)

What Paperwork Do I Need?

When you meet your trainers at **22.00**, they will need to see the following:

- Note: It is not essential to be a member of either canoe unions to undertake training. However, we recommend that all students join before attending. Tel BCU on 0845 370 9500; or Tel SCA on 0131 317 7314.
- BCU 4 Star Leader Surf Award or old Level 3 Surf Award.

What We Cover

This three-day course will provide relevant training to allow paddlers to work towards sitting their BCU 5 Star Surf Leader Assessment. The 5 Star Surf Leader Award is a discipline specific award and you will receive training in surf in appropriate advanced surf conditions and environments.

During the training course time will be spent covering the BCU Advanced Surf Safety and Rescue course in addition to time spent covering all aspects of the 5 Star Surf Leader syllabus which will include; personal paddling, leadership, tidal awareness, surf forecasting, surf awareness, equipment and environmental awareness. All this will take place on appropriate advanced 3 foot and above surf.

The three day package will provide you with everything you need to progress on to 5 Star Leader assessment.

All of the above will be covered using the fantastic locations that the north coast has to offer in the Thurso area. Our accommodation also has classroom facilities.

The course will finish by giving you a clear feedback and an action plan as to how to progress to a BCU 5 Star Surf Leader Assessment.

What Will I Need?

If you need equipment please let us know in advance so we can bring it across for you, a form is attached. Please return the form even if no equipment is needed.

Glenmore Lodge has a large, and very comprehensive store of up to date clothing and equipment. You are welcome to use your own equipment and pick and choose odd items from the store. Your instructor will want to check that personal equipment is appropriate for the activity.

If you are thinking about buying equipment but are not too sure what to get we would advise you to come and try our equipment and then make your purchases after the course.
